

>>SPRING PUNNY RUNNER<<

## **Supplies:**

1 fat quarter (for center main print)
1/4 yard background fabric
1/4 yard bright pink
5" x WOF of light pink
1/4 yard of mint
1/2 yard of mint for backing
1/4 yard of bright pink for binding

Read all instructions before starting. All seam allowances are 1/4". WOF=Width of fabric. HST = half square triangle **Cutting:** 

From main print 1 - 14" x 14" square (E)

From background 2 - 1.5" x WOF strips Sub cut into: 4 - 1.5" x 14" strips (C)

1 - 3 1/4" x WOF Strip Sub cut into: 12- 3 1/4" x 3 1/4" squares (B)


From dark pink 8 - 3 1/4" x 3 1/4" squares (A)

From light pink 4 - 3 1/4" x 3 1/4" squares (A) From mint print: 1 - 2.5" x WOF strip Sub cut into: 2 - 2.5" x 14" strips (D) 1 - 1.5" x WOF strip Sub cut into:


2 - 1.5" x 14" strips (F)

2 - 1.5" x 33" strips (G)


From binding: 3 - 2.5" x WOF strips




Place an A square and a B square right sides together.



Mark a line from corner to corner. Stitch 1/4" from each side of the drawn line.




With a rotatory cutter and ruler, cut along your marked line.




Press your half square triangles to the dark side. **Trim to 2.75" x 2.75"** 


## Make 8 - light pink half square triangles Make 16 - dark pink half square triangles



Layout your half square triangles as pictured.




Sew the top two HST's together and press. Sew the bottom two HST's together and press.





Sew the two units together and press. Pinwheel should measure 5" x 5"


Make 2 - light pink pinwheels Make 4 - dark pink pinwheels




Sew together two sets of three pinwheels. Press. Each unit should measure 5" x 14"












Sew your E square to the left unit. Press. Then add your right unit and press.

Start with your pinwheels and sew a C strip to the right side. Press. Then sew a D strip to the right side of the C strip and press. Sew a C strip to the right side of the D strip. Press.

Make 2



Now you are ready to baste, quilt and bind with your preferred method!
