## Mix Match Quilt

## Fort Worth fogroic studio



Finished size 48.5" $\times 60.5^{\prime \prime}$

Read all instructions prior to starting. Seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ ". WOF = Width of fabric
Supplies:
Blocks - (10) $1 / 3$ yard fabric cuts
Binding - $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
Backing - 3.25 yards
*Fabric: So Ruby by Carina Gardner for Riley Blake Designs

## Cutting Instructions:

Blocks:
From each $1 / 3$ yard fabric:
Cut (1) strip $6.5^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF and sub-cut into (4) $6.5^{\prime \prime} \times 8.5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Label (A).
Cut (1) strip $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF and sub-cut into (6) $4.55^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Label (B).
Total required for quilt: (40) $6.5^{\prime \prime} \times 8.5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles $(A)$ and (60) $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 4.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares $(B)$
Binding:
Cut (6) strips $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF.

## Block Assembly Instructions:

1. Sew together (2) $6.5^{\prime \prime} \times 8.5^{\prime \prime}$ Rectangles $A$. Sew along $8.5^{\prime \prime}$ edge. A2 block measures $8.5^{\prime \prime} \times$ 12.5".

Make a total of (20) A2 Blocks.

2. Sew together (3) Square B pieces. B3 block measures $4.5^{\prime \prime} \times 12.5^{\prime \prime}$. Make a total (20) B3 Blocks.

3. Sew together (1) A2 block and (1) B3 Block. Unfinished Block measures 12.5" $\times 12.5^{\prime \prime}$. Make a total of 20 Blocks.

4. Join 4 blocks together to form one row. Each row measures $12.5^{\prime \prime} \times 48.5^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat until you have sewn 5 rows. Rotate blocks randomly into desired position.

5. Sew together all 5 rows to complete quilt top. Mix Match Quilt finishes at $48.5^{\prime \prime} \times 60.5^{\prime \prime}$.


## Quilt Finishing:

Baste, Quilt, and Bind with preferred method.
