# Scrappy Star table topper

Read all instructions before starting. Seam allowances are 1/4" WOF - Width of Fabric HST - half square triangle.

## Supplies:

10 Fat Eighth's of assorted green fabrics
3/4 yard of background
$1 / 4$ yard of binding
$30^{\prime \prime}$ of backing

## Cutting:

From Background:
8-3" x 3" squares (A)
4-3.5" x $3.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares, cut in half diagonally, (D)

$8-3^{\prime \prime} \times 5.5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (B)
2-1.5" $\times 15.5^{\prime \prime}$ strips (F)
2-1.5" $\times 17.5$ strips (G)
$2-1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 21.5$ strips (H)

$2-1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 23.5$ strips (I)


3-2.5" $\times 3$ 7/8" rectangles (J)

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4-2.5" $\times 2.5$ rectangles (K)

## Block assembly:



Take a dark C triangle and light C triangle and sew them together. Press. Make 2. Sew the two units together to make your hourglass block. Press. Trim to 5.5"x 5.5"


Take a D background triangle, and a D green triangle and sew right sides together. Trim half square triangle units to $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$


Start with the B rectangle and place an E square right sides together. Mark a line from corner to corner and stitch (dotted line) on that line. Trim off (gray line) excess $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from your stitched line. Press. Do the same to the right side of the $B$ rectangle.
Make 4 light green flying geese units and 4 dark green flying geese units.


Take your center hourglass unit and sew two flying geese units to the left and right side press.
Sew an A square to the remaining two light colored flying geese units.


Sew them to the top and bottom of your center unit. Press.


Sew the left and right side units on and press.


Sew the top and bottom unit on and press. Block should measure $15.5^{\prime \prime}$ x 15.5"


Sew a short strip set to the left and right sides. Press. Sew the longer strip sets to the top and bottom. Press.


Take the dark flying geese units and sew a HST unit to the left and right sides. Make two.
Take the remaining two dark flying geese units and sew a HST unit to the left and right sides and then add an A square to the left and right side. Make two.


Sew F strips to the left and right sides. Press. Sew G strips to the top and bottom press.


Sew an H strip to the left and right side. Press. Sew an I strip to the top and bottom. Press.

Now you are ready to baste, quilt and bind.
