WOF = width of fabric
HST = half square triangle
QST = quarter square triangle

$4-5^{1 / 2 \prime 2} \times 5^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares (F)

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## Block instructions

Step 1: Draw a guideline from corner to corner on the wrong sides of all H squares. Place an H square and an E square right sides together. Stitch a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on either side of marked guideline. With a rotary cutter and ruler, cut on your guideline. This method will yield 2 HST units. Trim HST units to $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
Make 16 " $E$ " HST units.


Step 2: Sew a B triangle and an A triangle together. Press. Sew a $G$ triangle and an A triangle together. Press.

Join the two triangle units together to make your QST.
Press. Trim QST units to $5^{1122^{\prime \prime}} \mathbf{x} 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Make 8 " $A$ " units.


Step 3: Sew a C triangle and a D triangle together. Press. Sew a G triangle and a C triangle together. Press.

Join the two triangle units together to make your QST. Press.
Trim QST units to $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
Make 8 "C" QST units.


Step 4: Sew an "E" HST units on either side of a "C" QST unit. Press. Make 4.

Sew "E" HST units on either side of an "A" QST unit. Press. Make 4.


Step 5: Sew "C" QST units to either side of an F square. Make 2.

Sew "A" QHST units on either side of an F square. Press. Make 2.

Step 6: Join rows together to form your star blocks.
Blocks should measure: $15.5^{\prime \prime} \times 15.5^{\prime \prime}$

Step 7: Join blocks together into rows of two, and sew rows together. Press.
Center of quilt should measure $30.5^{\prime \prime} \times 30.5^{\prime \prime}$


Step 8: Measure left and right side of quilt top and cut border strips to correct size. Sew to the left and right side. Repeat same method for top and bottom border strips.


Step 9: Baste, quilt, and bind with your preferred methods. Quilt finishes 37" x 37"
