Read all instructions before starting.

All seam allowances are 1/4"

WOF = width of fabric

HST = half square triangle

QST = quarter square triangle



4 - 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares, cut twice diagonally. (A)

7 1/2" x WOF



2 - 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares, cut twice diagonally. (B)

7 1/2" x 22"



4 - 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares, cut twice diagonally. (C)

7 1/2" x WOF



2 - 6 1/2" x WOF strips

Subcut:

2 - 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares, cut twice diagonally. (D)

8 - 6 1/4" x 6 1/4" squares (E)

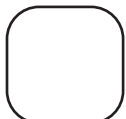
14" x WOF



4 - 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares (F)

(you can fussy cut these from your fat quarter)

Fat Quarter



2 - 6 1/2" x WOF strips

Subcut:

4 - 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares, cut twice diagonally. (G)

8 - 6 1/4" x 6 1/4" squares (H)

14" x WOF



4 - 4" x WOF strips (Border)

17" x WOF



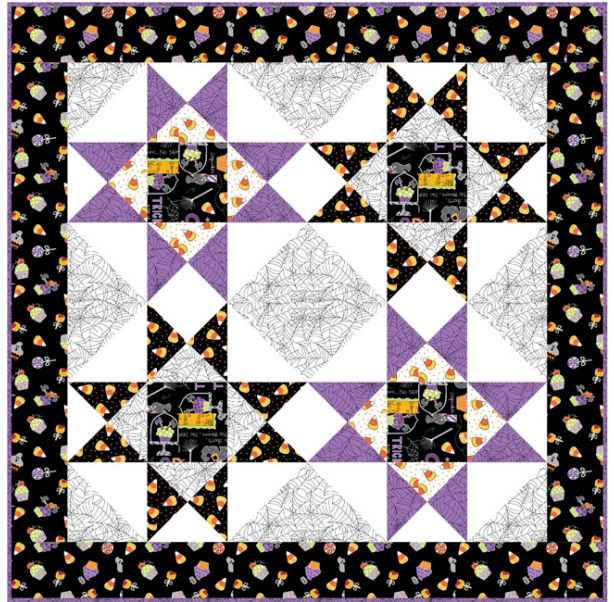
4 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips (Binding)

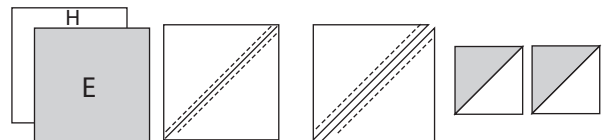

## Block instructions

**Step 1:** Draw a guideline from corner to corner on the wrong sides of all H squares. Place an H square and an E square right sides together. Stitch a 1/4" on either side of marked guideline. With a rotary cutter and ruler, cut on your guideline. This method will yield 2 HST units.

**Trim HST units to 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" square.**

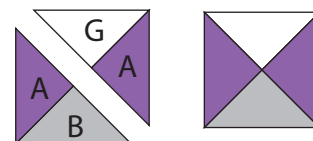
**Make 16 "E" HST units.**



**Step 2:** Sew a B triangle and an A triangle together. Press. Sew a G triangle and an A triangle together. Press.

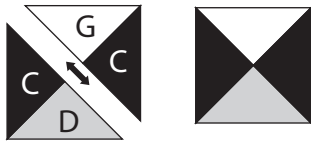
Join the two triangle units together to make your QST. Press. **Trim QST units to 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" square.**

**Make 8 "A" units.**



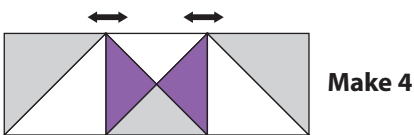
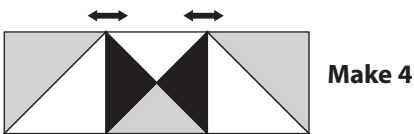
**Step 3:** Sew a C triangle and a D triangle together. Press. Sew a G triangle and a C triangle together. Press.

Join the two triangle units together to make your QST. Press.  
**Trim QST units to 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" square.**  
**Make 8 "C" QST units.**



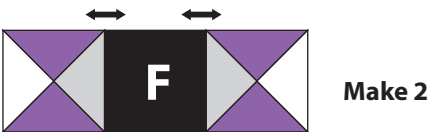
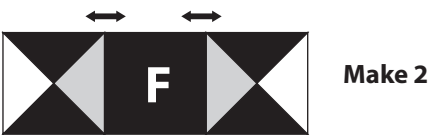
**Step 4:** Sew an "E" HST units on either side of a "C" QST unit. Press. **Make 4.**

Sew "E" HST units on either side of an "A" QST unit. Press. **Make 4.**

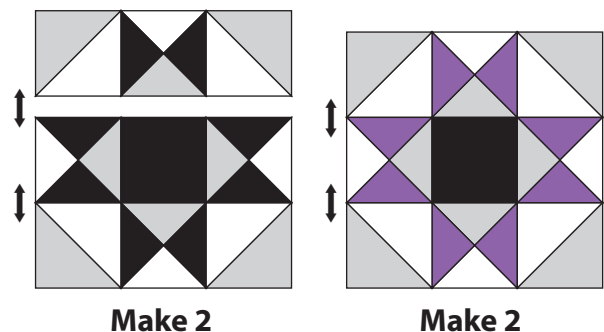


**Step 5:** Sew "C" QST units to either side of an F square. **Make 2.**

Sew "A" QHST units on either side of an F square. Press. **Make 2.**

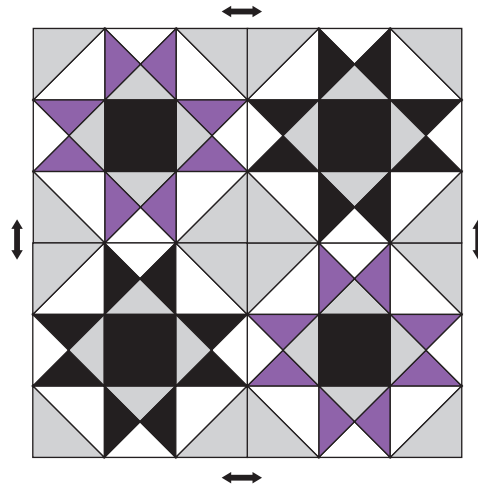


**Step 6:** Join rows together to form your star blocks. **Blocks should measure: 15.5" x 15.5"**

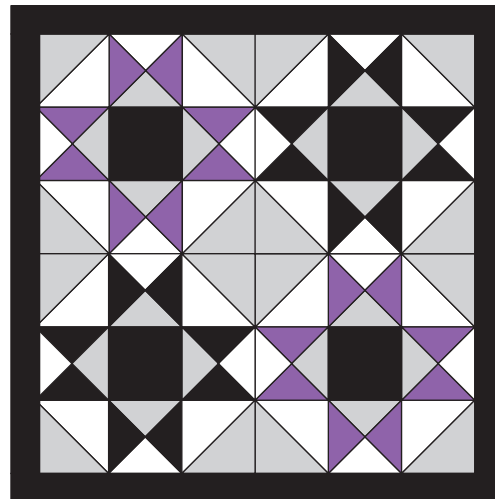


**Step 7:** Join blocks together into rows of two, and sew rows together. Press.

**Center of quilt should measure 30.5" x 30.5"**



**Step 8:** Measure left and right side of quilt top and cut border strips to correct size. Sew to the left and right side. Repeat same method for top and bottom border strips.



**Step 9:** Baste, quilt, and bind with your preferred methods. **Quilt finishes 37" x 37"**
