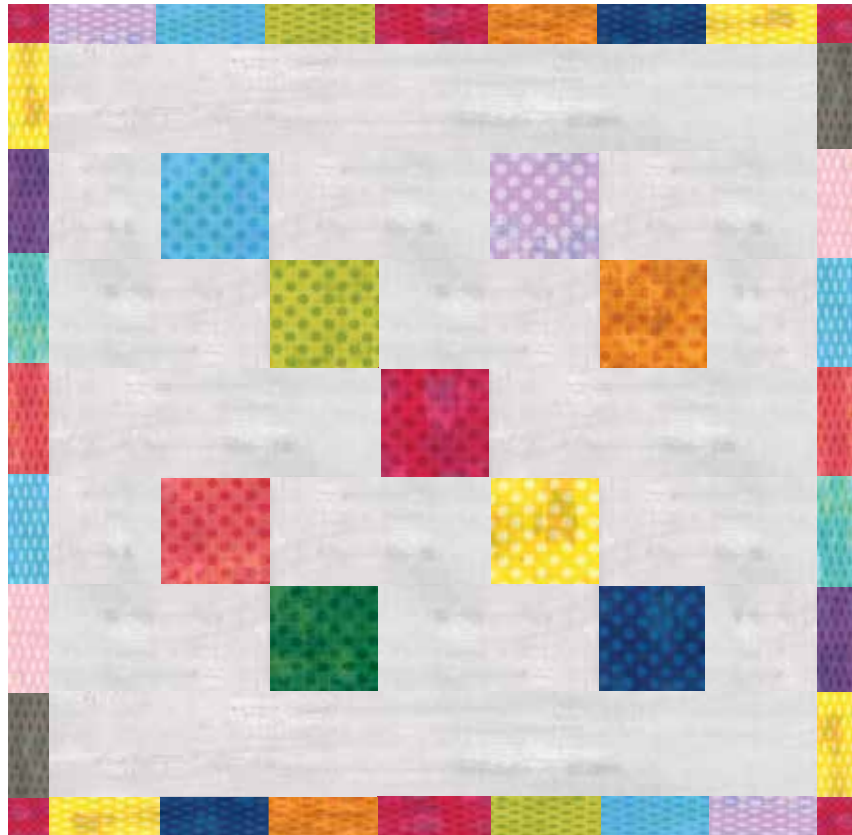


Walk Around The Block

Getting Started:

Please read all instructions first before you start cutting fabric.

All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ inch.

For this pattern, cut all strips from yardage from the width of fabric (WOF). Fabric amounts provided assume 40 inches of usable width once selvages are removed.

Fabric Requirements:

Background	$\frac{7}{8}$ yard Moda Grunge 30150-360 (Light Grey)
Blocks	1 charm pack (5" x 5" squares) Moda Grunge Hits the Spot New Colors!
Binding	$\frac{3}{8}$ yard Moda Grunge Dots 30149-34 (Black)
Backing	1 $\frac{1}{3}$ yard Moda Grunge 30150-360 (Light Grey)



What To Cut:

<i>Background</i>	# of strips	width of strip	size to cut	total # needed
	5	5 inches	See notes below	See notes below

From strip 1, cut the following sizes: (1) 32 x 5 inches, (1) 5 x 5 inches
 From strip 2, cut the following sizes: (1) 32 x 5 inches, (1) 5 x 5 inches
 From strip 3, cut the following sizes: (2) 14 x 5 inches, (1) 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 5 inches
 From strip 4, cut the following sizes: (4) 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 5 inches
 From strip 5, cut the following sizes: (3) 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 5 inches, (2) 5 x 5 inches

<i>Blocks</i>	# of charm squares*	size to cut	total # needed
	9	Do Not Cut (Leave as 5 x 5 inch squares)	Pick your 9 favorites!
	14	Cut in half to create 5 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch rectangles	Yields 28 rectangles
	1	Cut in half both vertically and horizontally to create 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares	Yields 4 squares

*You will have leftover charm squares. You can use them to make a custom backing for the quilt, a coordinating pillow or save them for a future project!

<i>Binding</i>	# of strips	width of strip
	4	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches

Assembling:

1. Lay out fabric and assemble according to the instructions below.

Row 1: 32 x 5 inch
background strip
(no assembling)



Row 2: Sew the following units together in this order : (1) 5 x 5 inch background square, (1) 5 x 5 inch favorite charm pack square, (1) 9 1/2 x 5 inch background rectangle, (1) 5 x 5 inch favorite charm pack square, (1) 9 1/2 x 5 inch background rectangle. Press seams open.



Row 3: Sew the following units together in this order : (1) 9 1/2 x 5 inch background rectangle, (1) 5 x 5 inch favorite charm pack square, (1) 9 1/2 x 5 inch background rectangle, (1) 5 x 5 inch favorite charm pack square, (1) 5 x 5 inch background square. Press seams open.



Row 4: Sew the following units together in this order : (1) 14 x 5 inch background rectangle, (1) 5 x 5 inch favorite charm pack square, (1) 14 x 5 inch background rectangle. Press seams open.



Row 5: Sew the following units together in this order : (1) 5 x 5 inch background square, (1) 5 x 5 inch favorite charm pack square, (1) 9 1/2 x 5 inch background rectangle, (1) 5 x 5 inch favorite charm pack square, (1) 9 1/2 x 5 inch background rectangle. Press seams open.



Row 6: Sew the following units together in this order : (1) 9 1/2 x 5 inch background rectangle, (1) 5 x 5 inch favorite charm pack square, (1) 9 1/2 x 5 inch background rectangle, (1) 5 x 5 inch favorite charm pack square, (1) 5 x 5 inch background square. Press seams open.

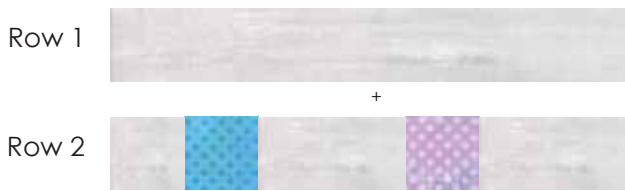


Row 7: 32 x 5 inch
background strip
(no assembling)

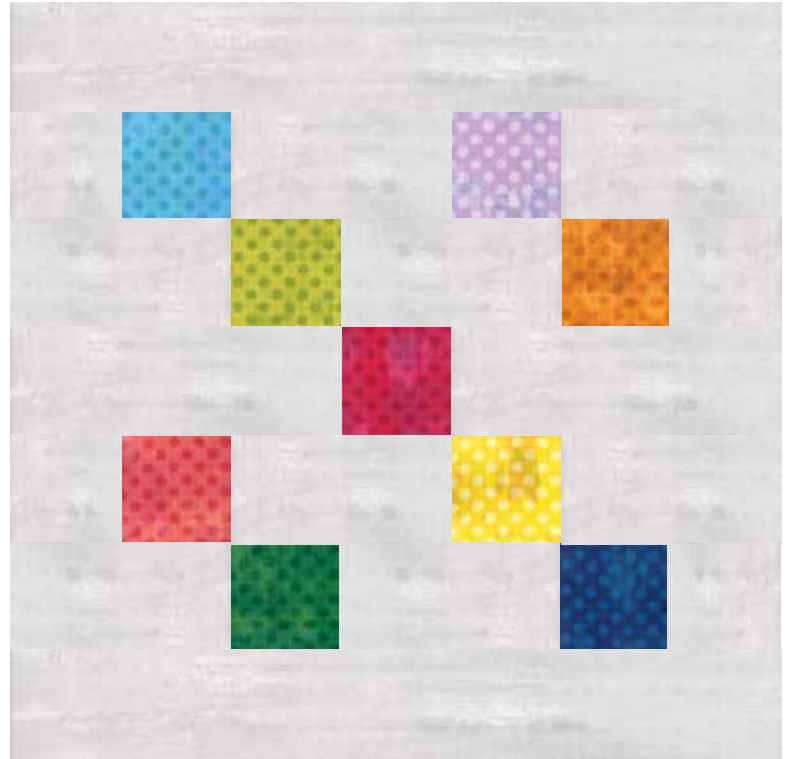


Assembling Continued:

2. Sew together Row 1 to Row 2. Press seams open. Continue with this method to sew on Row 3 and so on until all rows are sewn together.



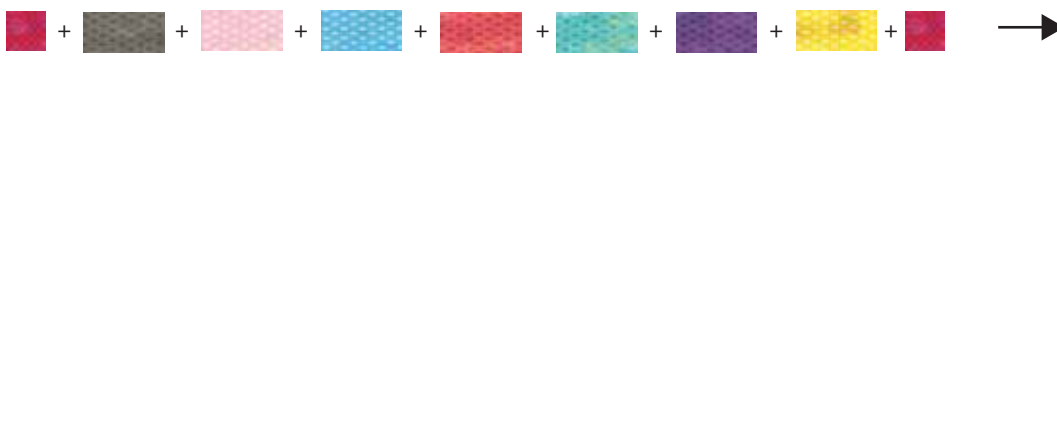
All seven rows sewn together →



3. Next, create the top and bottom borders. You may choose your own color order as you create each border unit. Sew together (7) $5 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ inch rectangles horizontally. This is the top border. Press seams open. Repeat this process to create the bottom border.

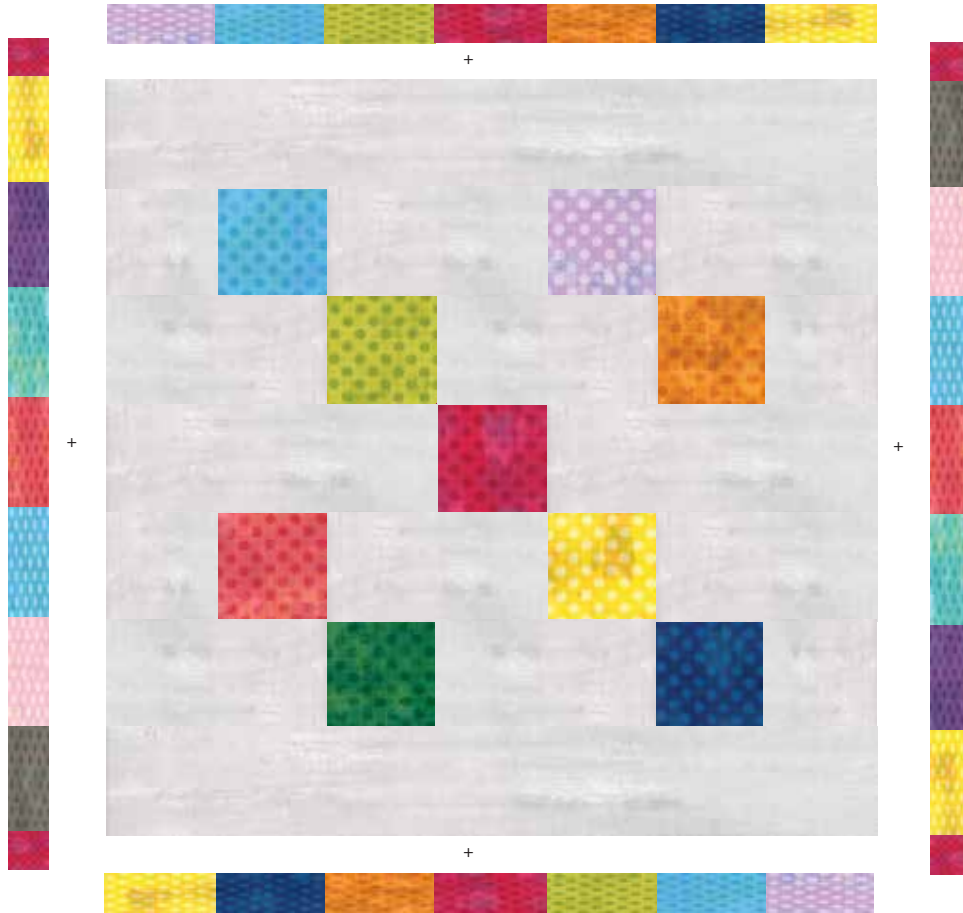


4. Next, create the left and right side borders. Sew together (7) $5 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ inch rectangles horizontally. Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch square to each end. This is the left side border. Press seams open. Repeat this process to create the right side border.



Assembling Continued:

5. Sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt top. Press seams open. Sew the left and right side borders to the quilt top. Press seams open.



6. Press quilt top. Prepare batting and backing. Baste. Quilt as desired. Bind. Label. Enjoy!
